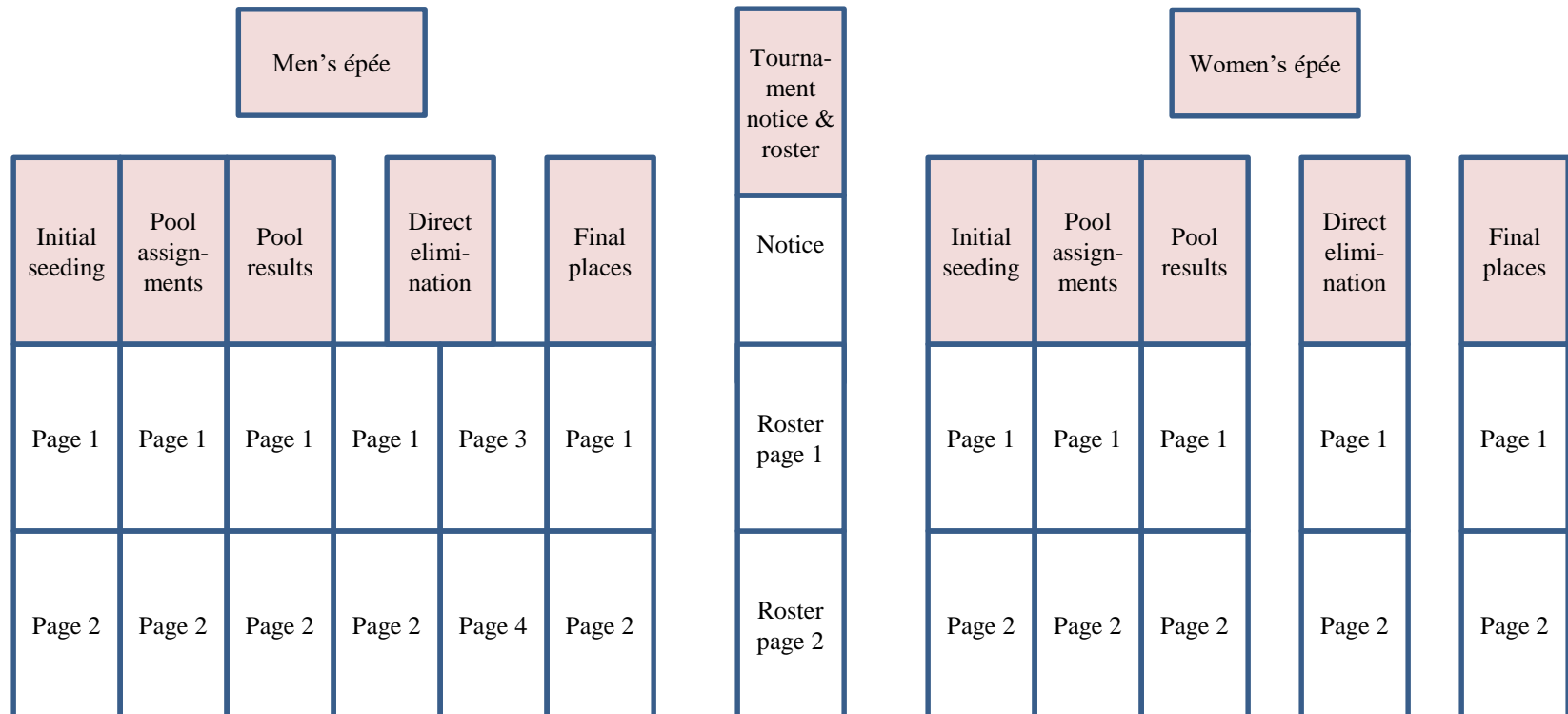


# Notes

The diagram below shows the intended layout of the results. Note that:

- The Tournament Notice and the Roster will be sent to you the day before the tournament.
- Most results pages will have about 60 lines. That means most results reports will be have two pages (women's results may fit on one page).
- The layout has additional space for the Direct Elimination bracket so that if there is a table of 128, the four pages of the bracket can be posted in two columns.
- When posting a DE bracket that uses fewer pages than the one previously posted (e.g., when replacing the table of 64 with the table of 32), always remove the previous bracket. Experience shows that fencers get confused if they can see their name twice.
- When printing the DE bracket in the table of 16 and later, always print from the table of 32. It will fit on one page and allows fencers to see what happened in earlier tables. Post the new bracket on top of the old.
- The men's and women's results will each need a space about 4' 3" wide.
